R.E.

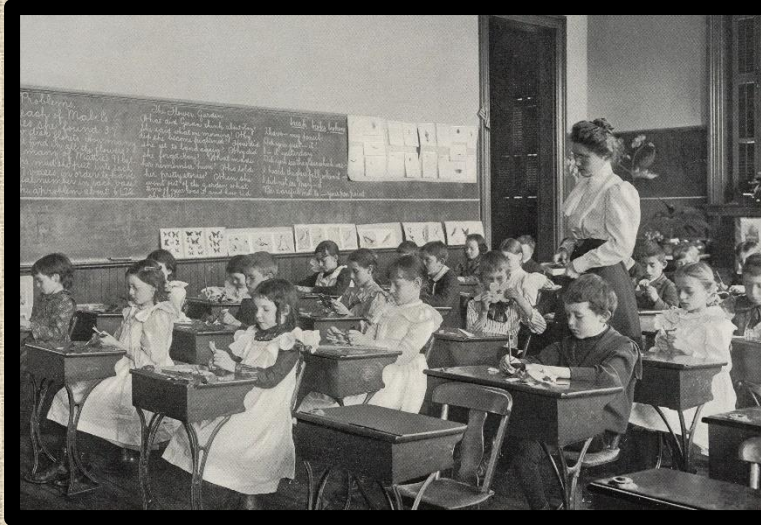
Mary, Our Mother

In R.E. this term, we will learn about Mary and her role in God's sending of his son, Jesus. The Nativity story will also link with this topic and the children will learn about the liturgical seasons of Advent and Christmas.

The children will learn about belonging to a family and how we can help and love each other. We will relate our own understanding of this to the stories of Jesus with his family.

Term 2-Term 3 **What was life like for Victorian children?**



History

We will look at aspects of Victorian childhood and compare it to our own lives, particularly education and toys. We will sort and compare classrooms, toys and objects from the past and present.

Through our Literacy text, 'Major Glad, Major Dizzy' the children will be introduced to timelines and family trees.

We will look at the significance of Charles Dickens and the connections he has to our locality.

Art

We will be studying the art work of William Morris and learning about the different techniques he used. We will then be creating our own prints.

DT

We will be designing and making peg dolls.

Literacy

In Phonics, children will be revising graphemes already taught and will learn alternative graphemes. We will continue to develop our fluency and pace when reading when decoding and blending words. We will continue to develop our sight reading and recall of high frequency words.

We will continue to incorporate GPaS (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling) into our daily Literacy lessons by ensuring we are composing sentences accurately with capital letters, finger spaces and correct punctuation. We will also have GPaS focused lessons on EdShed. We will be focusing on suffixes for plural nouns and the suffixes 'ed' and 'ing'.

Our Literacy texts for this term are, 'Major Glad, Major Dizzy' as well as the Victorian classic 'Oliver Twist'. Both texts will give us another perspective to our question for the term as well as help us see how toys have changed over time. Using these texts, we will compose recounts, posters and newspaper reports. We will use these texts to develop our comprehensions and inference skills.

Other

We will visit Guildhall Museum in Rochester to see Victorian artefacts and learn about how they were used by Victorian families.

Music Music

The Key Stage 1 Nativity in Term 2 will provide the songs and music that we will be learning this term. We will be rehearsing playing in time to a beat and singing expressively and creatively. In Term 3, we will be receiving music lessons from Dynamics Medway. We will develop our understanding of pitch and tempo, using untuned instruments.
