Art

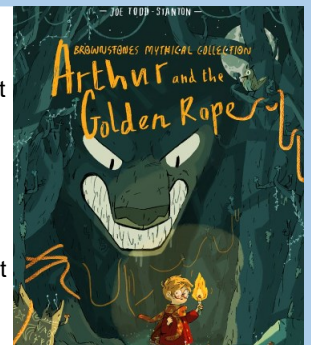
This week in art we have been making origami poppies for Remembrance Day. Poppies are used as a symbol for Remembrance Day. *(By Eva)*
