School tours will be available after school from October for prospective parents for our new Year R class.

**Harvest Collection** We are accepting any donations of canned / dry goods to help support the following charities: Caring Hands in the Community and the Medway Foodbank. We ask that donations are received on or before Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October, thank you for your support.

**Mustard Seed Relief Missions - Love in a Box** annual shoe box appeal. Every child has been given a leaflet today for your information and use (if you choose to support this charity collection). In addition to adding useful items such as toothbrush/toothpaste/soap/flannel etc., we encourage the children to donate a small toy(s) of their own that they no longer play with.
