# NEWSLETTER NO 9: Friday 13th November 2020

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for the continued support and understanding that you have shown this week. Across Kent, there is a rise in positive cases, with the Medway area seeing some of the highest numbers of cases in the country. Unfortunately, this has affected our school community over the last two weeks. As such positive cases, across schools has become part of our "new normal" please know that my team and I are doing all that we can to keep our school community safe.

As you may be aware within our school community/family we have a number of staff members having to self-isolate at this time and also two class bubbles closed. We are missing them from our school family, but I'm sure you'll join with me in sending our thoughts and prayers to them at this time. We look forward to having Year 4 back with us on Monday16<sup>th</sup> and Year 5 on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> November. I want to reassure you that our top priority is to keep our school open and as a team, we have pulled together and put measures in place to ensure teaching and learning continues for all pupils

I would like to reassure you that our measures of control within school are based on robust and ongoing risk assessments following Government guidelines. We are confident in the thorough protective measures that we have put in place and we are ensuring that everyone in our school continues to follow them.

#### **Attendance**

As you are aware we are now in another National Lockdown, but we remain open. It remains very important for children to attend, to support wellbeing and education and working parents/carers.

Health Reminders - A reminder to parents: dropping off and collecting children from school

It is extremely important that you follow social distancing rules when dropping off and collecting your child/children. Social distancing is vitally important to prevent the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19).

Please remember that when dropping off or picking up your child/children, you should:

- Wash your hands (20 seconds = a thorough wash) or use hand sanitiser before you arrive at school;
- Keep more than 1 metre apart from other parents and staff (ideally 2 metres);
- Only one member of your household should arrive at the school gates to collect your child/children (to help reduce the number of people at the school gate during pick-up times);
- Do not gather at the gates/outside school and leave as soon as you have seen your child walk through the gate. Using the one-way system by crossing over to the other side of Canon Close.
- If you need to visit the school reception area, then a face covering must be worn.

Please note that face coverings are optional to wear outside of the school; you can choose to decide to wear one at the school gates/outside school.

#### Ventilation

Following Government guidance to minimise the spread of the virus we have been following advice to keep rooms as well ventilated as possible. If your child is particularly susceptible to the cold then a base layer of a vest or t-shirt might be suitable as well.

## **New Addition to our School Uniform**

As mentioned previously, we have added a navy fleece zip jacket to our school uniform list.
