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

Dear Parents / Carers,

Pupil Premium Funding

We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can. Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for pupil premium. The pupil premium is additional funding for publicly funded schools in England. It is designed to help disadvantaged pupils of all abilities perform better, and close the gap between them and their peers. Your child is eligible for pupil premium if you are in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit)

Registering could also raise extra funding for our school to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities.

Registration is now required to be completed on line and has a quicker response to the old paper system. You will need to register at https://www.medway.gov.uk/info/200164/school_information/354/free_school_meals/1

click on Apply for Free School Meals and then follow the instructions.

Apply for free school meals

To make an application for free school meals you must apply online. Paper applications are no longer available. You will need to provide:

- your name
- your date of birth
- contact details
- your national insurance number or national asylum seekers number
- child's name
- · child's date of birth
- school your child is attending or will attend

Apply for free school meals

Reviews and changes in circumstance

You must update your details using our online free school meal system if there are any changes to your circumstances or school, so we can make sure your child still receives their free school meals.

Regular reviews will be carried out once per month and contact will be made if your entitlement changes or if any further information is required.

If you are struggling financially, even if you are not eligible for pupil premium funding, please do not suffer in silence. Please come and speak to me, Mrs Eastwood or any member of staff that you feel comfortable with. Conversations will be held in the strictest of confidence.
