Branded sunhats or fashion items may not be worn.</p> <p>Hair: If hair is long, it should be tied back in plain black hair elastics or plain elastics in school colours. For field activities children may wear trainers or football boots (no metal studs). In cold weather children are allowed to wear black or navy sweatshirt and tracksuit bottoms over their P.E. kit.
