<u>Maths</u>

In Maths we will be looking at: Place Value within 20:

- Reading, writing and counting (forwards and backwards) numbers within 20
- Tens and Ones
- Counting one more and one less
- Comparing amounts and numbers
- Ordering amounts and numbers

Addition and Subtraction within 20

- Number bonds to 20
- Adding by counting on
- Finding number facts
- Subtracting by 'taking away' (crossing out).

<u>R.E.</u> <u>Families and Celebrations</u>

The children will learn about belonging to a family and how we can help and love each other. We will relate our own understanding of this to the stories of Jesus with his family.

<u>Science</u> <u>Materials</u>

We will be looking at simple, everyday materials and investigating, comparing and grouping their physical properties.

We will also be carrying out investigations about the moon and rockets!

<u>History</u>

Using the moon landing as our focus point, we will be looking at the lives of significant people in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements in space travel.

We will also use the moon landing and other spacerelated events to create historical timelines.

<u>Other</u>

We will visiting Rochester Cathedral to see the 'Gaia' installation, by the artist, Luke Jerram (whose work also featured in the 'Museum of the Moon' exhibition). 'Gaia' is a globe made up of NASA photography and allows us to experience an astronauts view of the world.

Literacy

We will be focusing on our 'Power of Reading' texts: 'Beegu' and 'Man on the Moon' . We will use these texts as stimuli for our writing. We will create: postcards, leaflets, and stories in relation to these texts.

<u>Computing</u> <u>Digital Writing</u>

Children will develop their understanding of the various aspects of using a computer to create and manipulate text. They will become more familiar with using a keyboard and mouse to enter and remove text and will also consider how to change the look of their text. The children will consider the differences between using a computer to create text, and writing text on paper.
